How to get there

By train: From Termini Station > Subway A get off at the Stop Lepanto > Bus 913 direction Camilluccia Trionfale (every 5 minutes) or in alternative > Subway A get off at the Stop Ottaviano Bus 990 or 913. Get off at bus stop Camilluccia Trionfale and then 20 meter walk.

By car: Highway A1 GRA (Grande Raccordo Anulare) Exit n° 6 direction ROMA CENTRO SAXA RUBRA FLAMINIO; Via Flaminia Nuova for about 2 km.; then follow direction Corso Francia (100 meters); turn right direction Via Vigna Stelluti; Piazza Dei Giuochi Delfici; Via Della Camilluccia drive for 2 km; Piazza Walter Rossi; turn right Via Igea; turn left Via Trionfale at the 2nd traffic light.

EA is not affiliated with any sect, religion, political party, organization or institution, it does not get involved in any controversies nor does it take positions or oppose any given cause.

There are no fees to be paid to be a member of EA. We maintain our financial self-sufficiency through voluntary contributions on the part of members. During our meetings we use the program first created by Alcoholics Anonymous to learn a new way to live in a satisfying way.

In our groups we can say whatever we feel, knowing that their confidences will be kept confidential. We respect members' anonymity and we do not ask questions.

We do not judge, we do not get involved in discussions or give advice. Everyone has their own opinion and is free to express it during the meeting.

We are “experts” only regarding our own personal experiences and the way in which we benefit from applying the program and from support we receive from EA.

In EA we avoid discussions about religion: this is a spiritual program but it is not based on any particular form of religion; all are welcome.

In EA we avoid gossiping; we meet to help ourselves and others recover our emotional health. Carelessness in repeating what was said in a meeting obstacles trust and growth of the program.
